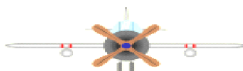

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### **HI-ALTITUDE AIRPORTS - REQUIREMENT**

ALL pilots seeking to fly to high altitude airports such as BIG BEAR, CATALINA etc.. REQUIRE a check out flight with a CFI to that destination. Pilots must be knowledgeable on the dangers of density altitude.

**NO pilots are allowed to fly to such destinations without a PRIOR check out.**

Midfield's restrictions on such flights, no more than two persons and half tank fuel. For all the details, talk further with CFI & Midfield Mgt.

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- ◆ **BE GENTLE WHEN HANDLING AIRCRAFT DOORS- DO NOT SLAM OR FORCE SHUT, CAUSES DAMAGE**
 - ◆ **PROPERLY TIEDOWN AIRCRAFT AFTER FLIGHT**

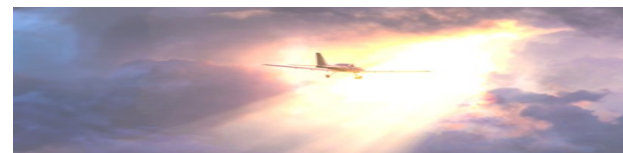
